Multi-Engine Instrument Rating Training Costs

The Instrument Rating allows you to operate an aircraft under Instrument Flight Rules.

This Training Cost sheet is based on the following assumptions:

1. Student has completed the Private Pilot Licence
2. Student has completed the Multi-Engine Rating
3. Student has a minimum of 50 hours of PIC cross-country time
