The commercial pilot licence allows the holder to fly for hire or reward in a commercial air service.

Actual cost will vary depending on student ability and study skills.

The Commercial Pilot Licence requires a minimum of 200 hours total time. 100 hours of this time must be solo. Build up time is required since the Transport Canada minimums do not equal the required 200 Hours of Total Time. The above estimate includes the night rating.

Unless special arrangements are made through the Chief Flying Instructor, all costs are due at time of expenditure.

Additional Costs:

- Medical Examination is the responsibility of the student. Average medical cost is \$150.00.
- Flight Test, Transport Canada Licencing Fees and Examination fees. Approx. \$615.00.
