Recreational Pilot Permit Program Outline

Age: Minimum of sixteen years of age.

Medical Fitness: Category 4 Medical Certificate valid for a Pilot Permit - Recreational - Aeroplane.

Aircraft used: Cessna 172

Knowledge:

An applicant shall have obtained a minimum of 60 percent (60%) in each of the following four mandatory areas, as well as in the overall written examination Pilot Permit - Recreational - Aeroplane (RPPAE), or Private Pilot Licence - Aeroplane (PPAER):

i) Air Law ii) Navigation iii) Meteorology iv) Aeronautics General knowledge

Experience:

The student shall have completed a minimum of 25 hours recreational pilot flight training under the direction and supervision of the holder of a flight instructor rating - aeroplane in aeroplanes operating with a Certificate of Airworthiness.

The flight training shall include a minimum of:

15 hours dual instruction flight time, including a minimum of 2 hours cross country flight time.

5 hours solo flight time.

Skill:

Within the 12 months preceding the date of application for the permit, the student shall successfully complete a flight test to the standard outlined in the Flight Test Standard - Recreational Pilot Permit – Aeroplane.
