



Multi-Engine Rating Training Costs

The Multi-Engine Instrument Rating allows you to fly aircraft with more than one engine.

There is no Transport Canada Minimum Training requirement. Hours required are based on safety and the ability to meet the Flight Test Standards.

The actual cost will vary depending on student ability and study skills.

Unless special arrangements are made through the Chief Flying Instructor, all costs are due at time of expenditure.

Additional Costs:

- Flight test and Transport Canada Licencing fees. Approx. \$ 685.00.
- Books and Supplies. Approx. \$ 50.00
