



## Private Pilot Licence Training Costs

The Private Pilot Licence allows a pilot to fly a single engine, non-high performance aircraft during daylight hours in VFR conditions. The Private Pilot Licence is fully upgradeable to include the Night Rating, Multi-Engine Rating, Instrument Rating, and Seaplane Rating. The Private Pilot Licence is also the starting point for the Commercial Pilot Licence.
