



Recreational Pilot Permit Training Costs

The Recreational Pilot Permit allows a pilot to fly during daylight hours only, and is restricted to fly within Canadian Airspace. The aircraft must have 160HP or less, 4 seats or less, with only one passenger. The Recreational Pilot Permit is only upgradeable to a Private Pilot Licence.
