Commercial Pilot Licence Training Costs

The commercial pilot licence allows the holder to fly for hire or reward in a Canadian Commercial Air Service.

The costs on this training cost sheet as based on the following:

1. Student has completed a Canadian Private Pilot Licence.
2. Student is interested only in completing the Commercial Pilot Licence
3. Student is responsible for build-up time as required to meet the course requirement of 200 hours total time/100 hours PIC including 20 hours of cross-country PIC

Aircraft: Cessna 172, ALSIM Flight Training Device

Minimum Course Ground School: 80 HOURS

Minimum Course Flight Hours: 65 HOURS FLIGHT TRAINING

30 hours solo flight time including 25 hours of improvement of general flying skills and 5 hours solo at night @ 165.00/hour	\$4,950.00

All prices are based on **TRANSPORT CANADA MINIMUM TRAINING REQUIREMENTS. Actual cost will vary depending on student ability and study skills.**

The Commercial Pilot Licence requires a minimum of 200 hours total time. 100 hours of this time must be solo. Build up time is required since the Transport Canada minimums do not equal the required 200 Hours of Total Time. Super T can provide directed build-up time if the student so wishes.

Unless special arrangements are made through the Chief Flying Instructor, all costs are due at time of expenditure.

Additional Costs:

- Medical Examination is the responsibility of the student. Average medical cost is \$150.00.
- Preparatory Ground Instruction \$35.00/hour
- Flight Test, Transport Canada Licensing Fees and Examination fees. Approx. \$740.00.
