Recreational Pilot Permit Training Costs

The Recreational Pilot Permit allows a pilot to fly during daylight hours only, and is restricted to fly within Canadian Airspace. The aircraft must have 160HP or less, 4 seats or less, with only one passenger. The Recreational Pilot Permit is only upgradeable to a Private Pilot Licence.

Aircraft: Cessna 172

Minimum Ground School: 40 Hours

Minimum Flight Hours: 25 Hours

Tuition for 40 hours of Recreational Pilot Permit Ground School – group instruction	\$600.00

Unless special arrangements are made through the Chief Flying Instructor, all costs are due at time of expenditure.

Additional Costs:

- Medical examination is the responsibility of the student. Average medical cost is \$150.00
- Flight test, Transport Canada Licensing fees and examination fees. Approx. \$575.00.
- Preparatory Ground Instruction - \$35.00/hour
